

CINNAMINSON BASEBAL COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT



The Coach's primary role is to teach ALL kids assigned to his/her team the fundamental skills of baseball in a fun, challenging and safe way. This includes teaching each player how to properly bat and how to play multiple positions on the defense. Coaches agree to attend any skill sessions that may be required by the Board of Directors and any first aid courses that may be mandated by the Board.

Coaches shall remain unconditionally supportive of the Cinnaminson Baseball's commitment to the ideals of a positive and fun atmosphere, good sportsmanship, team play, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect for authority. Skill development takes priority. Winning "at all costs" is not an acceptable attitude.

Coaches must agree to the following principals:

- Coaches will teach the game of baseball to the best of their ability and will continually work to improve their own understanding of the skills of the game and how to teach those skills.
- Coaches will be positive role models and will do their best to provide a positive experience for the players and for the parents.
- Coaches will display and teach their players the principals of good sportsmanship, respect and team play whether the team is winning or losing.
- Coaches will provide organized team practices each week (subject to the policies of Cinnaminson Baseball) that will provide for the development of both team and individual skills and will make full effort to provide practices that are both fun and challenging for the players.
- Coaches will not ridicule or demean players, umpires, or league officials.
- Coaches will be responsible for the conduct of their players and the parents during games.
- Coaches will treat all players, parents, spectators and league officials with respect.
- Coaches will not tolerate behavior that endangers the health or well-being of a child.
- Coaches will comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policy and procedures as established or endorsed by Cinnaminson Baseball.
- Coaches will be drug and alcohol free while at any Cinnaminson Baseball athletic event.
- Coaches will not use any tobacco products in the dugout or on the playing field.

I agree to abide by the policies outlined in this code of conduct. Further, I acknowledge that if I fail to comply with aforementioned rules and guidelines, I may be subject to disciplinary action levied by the Cinnaminson Baseball Board of Directors that could include, but are not limited to, (1) verbal warning, (2) written warning, (3) game suspension, (4) season suspension, and/or (5) removal from all league activities.
